Regional Transit Coordination

- Regional transit operations, funding discussions, and planning are evolving at a rapid rate.
- New service operations continue to come on line.

 There is continued interest and momentum for new and improved services and improved service coordination.

Existing Context

- <u>MARC</u>- regional planning, long range plan, STP/CMAQ project programming, transportation improvement program.
- <u>KCATA</u>- Designated recipient for federal transit funds (FTA programming), regional transit authority, regional operator, planning, service coordination lead.

• <u>Transit Operators</u>:

- KCATA
- Johnson County Transit
- Unified Government Transit
- Independence Transit
- Streetcar Authority (2015)
- <u>Additional Local Jurisdiction Funders</u>: KCMO, NKC, Lee's Summit, Blue Springs, Raytown, Blue Springs, Lee's Summit, Liberty, etc.

Existing Context, Cont.

MARC Transit Committee

- Originally intended to serve a long-term planning role (LRTP support)
- Not intended to solve technical, operations, or near-term coordination needs
- No formal connection to KCATA Board processes, other transit operators, or local jurisdiction funders.

Enhancing our transit service coordination model

- How do we better align the region's federal planning and programing roles and responsibilities?,
- How do we provide an effective forum for technical service coordination and planning, while effectively engaging operators and local jurisdiction funders?, and
- Now do we work within <u>existing</u> Board, and governance structures to develop an improved model for coordination in the near-term?

Regional Transit Coordinating Council Concept

- In partnership with KCATA, jointly develop and staff the regional transit coordinating council.
 - Co-chaired by MARC Board and KCATA Board appointee
 - Representation from existing transit service providers and local jurisdiction funders of transit service.
 - Serves as an advisory resource to existing boards.

Regional Transit Coordinating Council Concept, Cont.

Illustration of potential TCC agenda;

- Regional fare policies & technology integration
- Regional Service Coordination- Integration of existing and planned services
- Para-transit Service Coordination
- Regional Communications, Mapping, and Marketing
- Transit Study Coordination
- Regional Transit Funding Policy How do we prioritize the use of limited federal funds?

 Existing MARC Transit Committee would be retained, but the work plan and function would be reassessed overtime to align with TCC, and TTPC's needs.

Next Steps

- MARC and KCATA staff leadership have met and agree there is value in jointly pursing and advancing the TCC concept
- Engage transit operators and funders to gage feedback
- Seek MARC Board and KCATA Board authorization to formalize TCC (as early as February)
